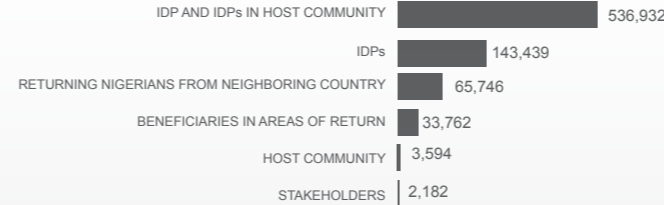

# OF BENEFICIARIES BY AGE AND GENDER

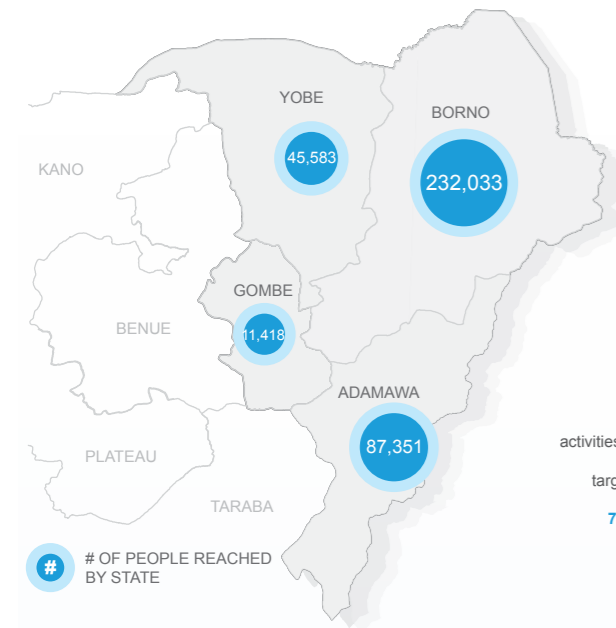
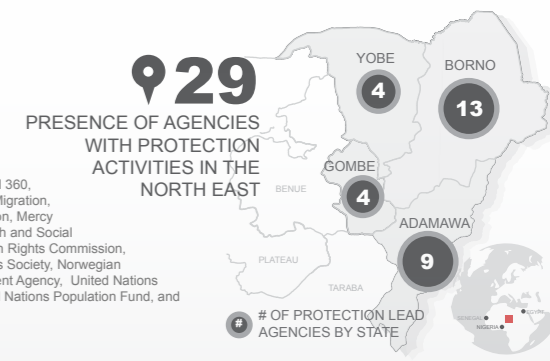


# OF BENEFICIARIES BY TYPE

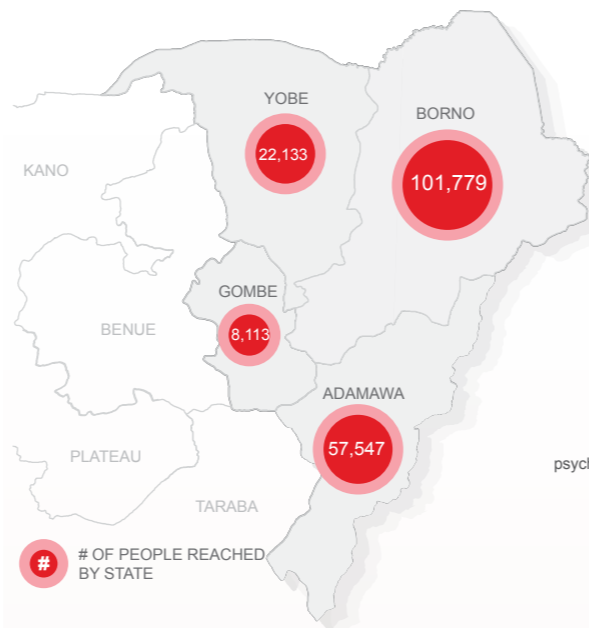


## PROTECTION

376,385 individuals reached with protection activities including 187,235 vulnerable persons screened or profiled, 64,581 vulnerable persons provided with targeted material assistance, 62,840 persons reached through awareness raising and community-based initiatives, 7,174 individuals referred to appropriate specialized services

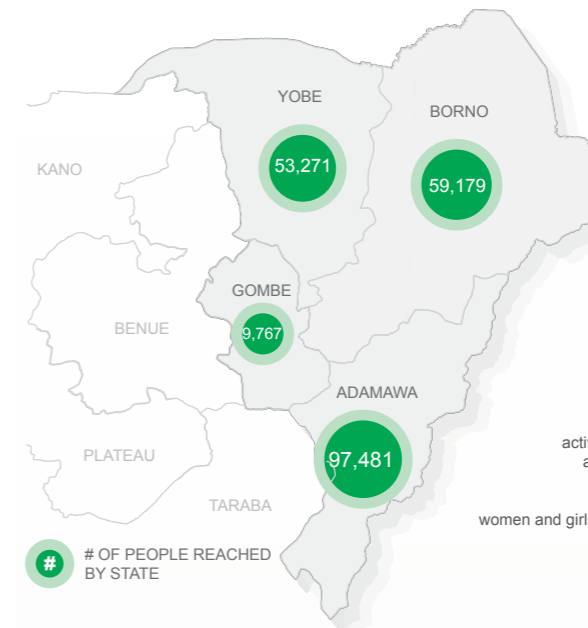


## CHILD PROTECTION

PEOPLE REACHED **189,572**

### CURRENT SITUATION

189,572 individuals reached with Child Protection activities including 167,647 boys and girls reached with psychosocial support through 265 child friendly spaces/child clubs, 3,691 unaccompanied and separated children identified and 151 reunified, 4,702 children at risk and survivors supported through inter-agency case management system.



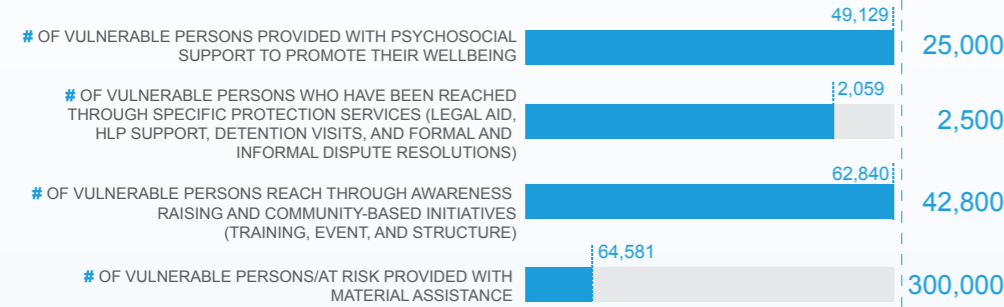
## SGBV SEXUAL AND GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

PEOPLE REACHED **219,698**

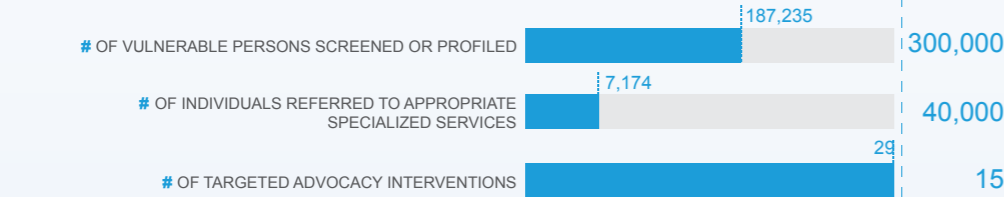
### CURRENT SITUATION

219,698 individuals reached with SGBV activities including 138,087 affected individuals reached with timely and appropriate psychosocial support, 64,059 persons reached through community sensitization on SGBV and SEA, 10,233 individuals provided with dignity kits, 1,448 vulnerable women and girls accessing livelihood support, 5,541 persons trained on SGBV interventions.

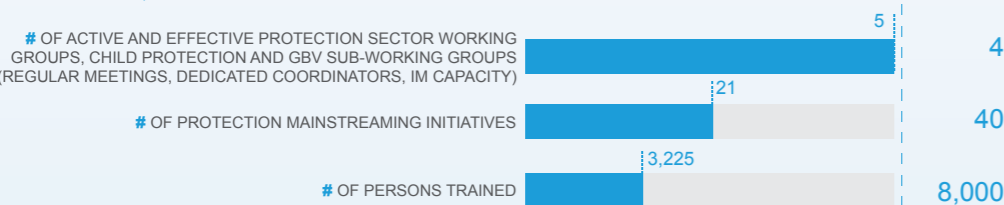
